SquareTrade tested the new iPhone SE, which Apple calls “the most powerful phone with a four-inch display,” against the iPhone 6s and 6s Plus. At first, it appears to be the brains of a 6s in the body of a 5s, but how does it compare to its larger siblings in breakability? While it holds its own against the much bigger 6s Plus, the new SE still has some growing up to do before it can compete with the durable 6s.
